February is often themed the month for Love. As I write this column, I am reflecting back to how you are allowing God to use you as a reflection of His love to the community around St. John's United Methodist.

We will have several special opportunities to show our love in the life of our church. February 5th will be another "Potato Sunday" as we offer tangible signs of love in the food offering we present. February will see us also hosting a visit from one of the local Gideon's to share a witness to this vibrant ministry and receiving an "Open Bible offering" as we leave the service. On February 19th, we will also hold a service of Renewal of Vows for those who would like to renew their wedding vows with their spouse. Finally, on February 26th, we will welcome the children from our pre-school and their families to share in song as a part of our worship.

Matthew 22:37 states "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul and with all your mind" and verse 39 continues "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

Reading this verse reminded me

that we don't always recognize who our neighbor is. Our neighbor is anyone God sends into the doors or ministries of our congregation – and you and I are called to love them all regardless of what race, class or level of life they come. All of these are God's children.

The Daily Guideposts provided this daily reading by Keith Miller that set me to thinking.

"I'd forgotten my promise to visit a sick friend in the hospital, and now he was dead. "I couldn't even remember to visit my dying friend!" I told another friend, "Maybe I should give my pew at church to someone who will really loves his neighbor as himself."

My friend just smiled and shook his head. "Keith, no one can live perfectly enough to earn God's love. That's why Jesus had to die for us." "I know that," I said, "but if I love God with all of my heart and soul and mind, then why can't I love my neighbor as myself?"

My friend looked at me for a few seconds. "Keith," he said, "I don't know about you, but if I really loved God with all of my heart and soul and mind, I would have more time to pray and read my Bible, and I'd

be a lot more focused on loving other people."

"Well, then," I said quietly, "how do I change?"

"When I realize I have forgotten to keep a promise," my friend said thoughtfully, "I look at exactly what I was doing when I forgot, because it was obviously more important to me than loving people for God.

Then I can ask God to help me surrender that absorbing thing I was doing to Him."

I thought about the day I forgot to visit my friend. I was working to get a project finished, and I didn't take time to pray or read my Bible or listen to the people around me who needed love and attention. At the center of my life, I'd replaced God with an idol – my work. I was heartbroken; it was time to ask God to help me change my priorities and surrender them to Him.

As I See It, Keith Miller isn't alone in often replacing God with other idols in our lives. Sometimes it's work, sometimes it's our superior attitudes, sometimes our unwillingness to be used by God for others. What's your idol?

In the month of February, when we focus on Valentines and the sharing of Love, I pray that I can keep this devotional in mind – and be filled with God's love so that I carry it in my daily priorities. I also pray that this will be the prayer for all of God's family – and what a different world we will begin to be a part. Maybe we can all pray this simple prayer this month –

Lord, help me to put You in the center of my life – and when I forget, please do whatever it takes to remind me. Amen.

MISSION TRIP: COSTA RICA

A small group of Friendship Circle women have been in contact with StreetAngels, another area non profit organization dedicated to feeding and helping those who are in need. StreetAngels is located at 628 West Central, behind Popeyes. The organization dishes out food, coupons good for hamburgers and pizza, clothes, blankets, flashlights, and is also available to help with co-payments for those needing medications. Currently, with the colder weather ahead, StreetAngels is in desperate need of sleeping beds and small tents. (Last year, 85 tents were given out.) IF you have a one or two person tent, not being used anymore by the grandkids, etc. please consider donating it to StreetAngels. 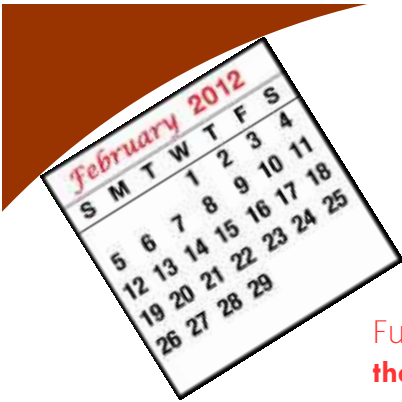
